Since we finished the tour of our previous album *Rose Escargot* we have announced the publishing of a new album in April 2008. The main thing about this project is that it is a **trilogy**, that's said, the work we present now is just the first chapter of the whole thing. Each part will have near twenty minutes of music so in the end we'll have a little- longer- than- usual album. It will be available in a year and a half period time, with the next dates for publishing:

First part 29 April 2008

Second part February 2009

Third part October 2009

The leading line of the trilogy are the **trash containers**. The three types we have in our town will name the three parts, and that's why the first part is titled *Materia organikoa eta gainerakoak* (Organic matter and rest), the second will make reference to paper and cardboard, and to plastic derivatives the last one.

They become a filing cabinet of each one's universe, a simple shelf in a warehouse where parts of life are the stock.
